#### **CLINICAL EXPERIENCE:**

I have been working in Misurata university hospital for the last 13 years (up to2013) as a consultant and head of unit B of surgery then at Misurata cancer centre as consultant surgeon and head of surgegical oncology department (2013- present). Misurata university hospital is a teaching hospital affiliated to Misurata University. It is a very busy hospital of 450 beds. It serves the middle part of Libya of catchment area of more than500,000 people. It is a referral hospital. It has a major trauma department, general surgical department, an orthopaedic department, neurosurgical department, medical department, paediatric department, gynaecology department and a well-equipped 20 bed intensive care unit. The operation suit contains 9 operation rooms. Most of the routine and emergency operations in different specialities are performed. The laboratory and the radiology department are well equipped. There is a pathology department is attached to it. It has a busy postgraduate centre which was established since 1995. Misurata cancer centre is a specialized centre covering the mid land region of Libya it is 250 bed hospital with 6 operation theatres and good radiology, histopathology, medical oncology, radiotherapy depatments.

All the postgraduate students and the Libyan and Arab board candidates have been trained here since 1995 in all the specialties already mentioned. We have been inviting many expert surgeons from Europe, north America and some Arab countries to train our surgeons and perform difficult operations and procedures that could not be performed by the local surgeons.

#### **Colorectal Surgery**;

My experience in colorectal surgery includes management of cancer colon and rectum, diverticular disease of the colon, different anal conditions. Cancer colon is being managed mostly by laparoscopic procedures. The following operations are performed frequently:• Right hemicolectomy• Left hemicolectomy• Sigmoid colectomy• Abdominoperineal resection• Hartman's procedures• Total colectomies with Ileo-anal anastomosis the number of colorectal operations being performed is minimum 2 cases per week.

**Laparoscopic Surgery and minimally invasive surgery**: I perform laparoscopic cholecystectomy, appendectomy, TAPP, para umbilical hernia repair diagnostic laparoscopy, adhesiolysis and splenic cystectomy different colorectal procedures, adrenalectomies ,hiatal hernia & antireflex procedures.

#### **Upper Gastrointestinal Surgery:**

My experience in Gastro-oesophageal surgery includes operations for peptic ulcer, hiatus hernia, cancer stomach and oesophagus, achalasia cardia and trauma. The operations carried out for peptic ulcer were truncal and highly selective vagotomy. and partial & total D2 gastrectomy were carried out for malignant disease of the stomach. The main indication for gastric surgery was complicated duodenal ulcer disease and gastric carcinoma **Hepatobiliary surgery:** 

operations performed include open and Laparoscopic cholecystectomies (the main procedure performed) with no moralities and acceptable rate of morbidity. The main indication of surgery was calcular disease. Carcinoma of the gall bladder and Cholangiocarcinoma constitute 2% of the operated cases where palliative procedures were performed. Different types of biliary resections and biliary enteric anastomosis are performed for benign and malignant conditions. Infrequently we see biliary trauma which we treated successfully in most of the cases. Liver surgery I have performed operations for hydatid cysts, liver abscess and trauma. More than 100 cases of hydatid cysts in the liver were managed mainly by endocystectomy and occasionally partial pericystectomy and total cystectomy. I have managed many cases of traumatic liver injuries with repair & partial hepatectomy.

## **Pancreatic surgery**

I have performed operations on pancreas for carcinoma, pseudocysts and true cysts. Pseudopancreatic cysts are operated by internal drainage, whipple's procedure and distal pacreatectomy, palliative triple bypass performed in advanced pancreatic cancer.

## **Splenic surgery**:

I have performed large numbers of open splenectomies for trauma, & laparoscopic splenectomy for pathological spleen mainly ITP, hydatid cysts.

#### Vascular surgery:

Most of my experience is in vascular trauma & varicose vein surgery.

#### **Breast Surgery:**

I perform all forms of breast surgery for benign and malignant conditions; wide local excisions, mastectomy and Axillary clearance.

## Thyroid surgery:

I perform all forms of thyroidectomy, neck dissection and parathyoidectomies for benign and malignant conditions.

## **Emergency surgery and war surgery:**

I have performed many operations on trauma cases that included splenctomies, operations on colonic injuries (resections and stoma formation), gastric injuries, liver injuries,

thoractomies for chest injuries and stab wounds to the hearts and many and different amputations. Since the Libyan revolution (17/2/2011) my department has been involved in the management of all types of war injuries.

Hernia surgery: I have performed many cases of hernia operation. Lechneistein procedure& TAPP are the standard treatment for inguinal hernia repair. The incisional hernia, umbilical hernia repair is performed by placement of (sublay) mesh & some cases operated laparoscopically. I have performed more than 200 cases with few minor complications.
