NEONATAL EXPERIENCE

I spent time in one of tertiary neonatal unit and this gave me confidence in assessing and managing acute and chronic problems in neonates.

As a middle grade I take the daily ward round on the NICU and also advised the SHO's with problems on the labour and postnatal wards ,

I was assigned to attend deliveries including high risk ,perform newborn discharge examination ,admit and follow up sick newborn.

OUT PATIENT EXPERIENCE

As a middle grade I take part in many clinics and perform clinics independently.

These clinics covers general paediatrics, community paediatrics and other subspecialty; Gastro, epilepsy, diabetes, asthma and baby clinic.

I feel competent in assessing new-referrals and making appropriate management plans as well as dealing with on-going outpatient care.

The almost 7 month rotation in PICU was very rich experience for me where I learned a lot about dealing with children ,infant who require intensive care due to variety of causes, I am becoming more familiar with different practices of respiratory cardiac vasopressor and neurological support ,able to assess, investigate and follow children in PICU , I effectively contributes to round discussion and decision making.

PRACTICAL PROCEDURES

During my time as a junior and middle grade doctor, I have become highly competent in many practical procedures including cannulation blood extraction, intubation including extreme preterm babies,

Giving surfactant ,urinary catheterization umbilical and long line access, central lines, supra-pubic aspiration, exchange transfusion and lumbar punctures. I have inserted several chest drains and I am capable of inserting central line under USS guidance, I have good knowledge of mechanical ventilator of different mods and brands.
